Steps to Success as a Varsity Scout Leader

Step 1. Take “Youth Protection Training” online at www.my.scouting.org

- Print Training Certificate to submit with Adult Application

Step 2. Register by completing an ADULT APPLICATION

- Submit Adult Application and Youth Protection Certificate to Scout Service Center

Step 3. Obtain the following RESOURCE MATERIALS

Step 4. Become a TRAINED leader:

RECOMMENDED

- Take Varsity Scout “Fast Start Training” (to be taken within 48 hours), and “This is Scouting”. These trainings may be taken online at www.my.scouting.org. Trainings may be taken without a Scout ID#. After you have registered, please retrieve your Scout ID# from the Scout Service Center and input your number and our council #591 into your MyScouting profile. Our council records will then be updated with your trainings.

- “Leader Specific Training” for your position is held various times per year. Please check online at www.utahscouts.org/training or check with your district or take the trainings online at www.my.scouting.org
- Troop Committee Challenge (for Team Committee Members – available at www.my.scouting.org)
- North Star Training – Outdoor Leadership Skills Course (check online for available courses)
- Other Online Trainings: Safety Afloat, Safe Swim Defense, Hazardous Weather, Climb on Safely, etc.
